The maximum word limit of abstract is 200 covering a brief background, materials and methods, results and conclusion. These abstracts are to be submitted in the prescribed format. Abstracts not confirming to the format will be rejected and will not be considered for review. Accepted abstracts will be called for oral presentation during the selected technical session.

The selected abstracts (max. 30) will be called only for oral presentation in the respective technical session for about 10 min duration. The presentation should be in MS PowerPoint mode only.
