After a success of the 1st 'National Level Seminar on Current Research in Biological and Biomedical Sciences 2016', the Department of Zoology is going to take a new initiative in organizing a five-day "Hands-on Training Workshop on Microbiological Tools and Techniques" on March 3 – 7, 2017.

Microbiology is an emerging subject in study with both PG and UG Zoology courses, in our part of the globe, and especially in the University of Gour Banga located at the centre of the West Bengal State, India. This Department has already started its Ph D as well as M Phil research in the field of Microbiology (Medical, Food Environment), and many students in the catchments showed great interest Microbiology research. Therefore this is the perfect time in organizing such workshop for the students at different level, and also for the faculties holding their research work in the field of biomedical sciences, from within and outside of the state of West Bengal.

This small but strong and new initiative certainly will open a new vista, especially in our region, for the students and researchers in microbiology and allied field of biomedical science.

Programme Highlights:

Training and practice: Isolation of bacteria from various samples, bacterial characterization (cultural, morphological and biochemical), antibiotic susceptibility testing (different in vitro methods); Plasmid DNA isolation, DNA and protein gel electrophorsis; detection and estimation of bioactive phytocomponents.

Lectures and interaction in the relevant fields.
